

## Terms and Conditions of Purchase

Per Requirements of AS9100C section 7.4.1 and 7.4.2

United Precision Machine is a Registered Company to ISO 9001:2008 and Aerospace AS9100C Standard. Seller and service providers to United Precision Machine must agree and follow the Terms and Conditions listed below, in order to provide United Precision Machine with raw materials or services.

For clarification purposes in this document, the term "Seller" shall refer to the Company or entity that United Precision Machine contracts with, via a formal Purchase Order, to provide the raw materials, components or services as required.

Materials include metals, plastics, etc. necessary for manufacturing / fabricating parts required by United Precision Machine customers. Other services required such as Heat Treating, Plating, Passivation, Grinding, Machining Processes, Laser Cutting, Non-Destructive Testing etc. are also included.

1. Acknowledgement of this Order is required within three (3) business days confirming definite quantity, price and delivery.
2. United Precision Machine reserves the right to cancel any item not received by the required date as denoted on the Purchase Order.
3. CERTIFICATION TO ALL APPLICABLE OR STATED SPECIFICATIONS MUST ACCOMPANY ALL MATERIAL, ITEMS or SERVICES. The seller must also agree to keep, retain, and maintain records that are legible, readily identifiable and are completely retrievable, that were produced during the manufacture of the product items and or services. United Precision Machine will request this records retention process when needed per the instructions provided on the Purchase Order.
4. The seller shall notify United Precision Machine of changes in product and or process, changes of sub suppliers, changes of manufacturing facility location in writing prior to vendor confirmation or immediately as applicable.
5. Acceptance of this purchase order gives United Precision Machine, its customers and regulatory authorities the right of access to the applicable areas of all facilities, at any level of the supply chain, involved in the order. This right of access shall also apply to all applicable seller/supplier records for the product or services provided per condition 4 above if applicable.
6. The seller must notify United Precision Machine in writing of the use of any and all sub-tier suppliers and flow down all applicable requirements as stated in purchase order document, including key characteristics as required.
7. The seller must notify United Precision Machine of nonconforming product. In the event of nonconforming product, the seller must obtain approval for disposition of nonconformance (i.e. rework, acceptance as is, etc.) if applicable from appropriate personnel at United Precision Machine.
8. By seller's acceptance of this Purchase Order, seller acknowledges its counterfeit risk mitigation obligations pursuant to section 13 of TC-001 or TC-004 (Whichever is applicable) that the goods to be delivered hereunder shall be and only contain materials obtained directly from the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) or an authorized OEM reseller or distributor. Further, seller shall notify buyer in writing immediately in the event that any material to be delivered cannot be procured in accordance with this requirement and seller must obtain buyer's prior written authorization if an alternate source is required and for any deviation from the counterfeit risk mitigation requirements applicable to this purchase order.
9. Seller must also adhere to and flow down all customer requirements for supplier to use customer-approved special sources (i.e.) NADCAP registered suppliers when producing product as outlined in the P.O.
